Dear Resident:

Enclosed are plans for the upcoming **“Prentice Drive - Southcrest Drive Drainage Improvement Project”**. This is a storm sewer construction project scheduled to begin mid-June. Construction will begin about 7:00 am Monday through Friday.

The project is covered by an intergovernmental agreement between DuPage County and Lisle Township Highway Department. It is being implemented to improve drainage, control flooding and manage stormwater runoff in the Suburban Estates Subdivision. The estimated cost is \$146,700 with DuPage County contributing funding totaling \$60,000 from their Drainage Assistance Program.

Construction will include work in the right-of-ways and roadway. Trenches will be dug along the path depicted in the attached site map. HDPE pipe of various diameters will be laid and then covered and the parkway restored. If you have any plantings or other objects in these public right-of-ways, they may be damaged or removed but not replaced. You may wish to remove them prior to construction.

Construction may also interrupt traffic in your area. We will work to minimize any anticipated inconvenience to residents. 
