ORDINANCE NO. 2011-

TAX ABATEMENT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Lisle Township Board did adopt an Ordinance levying taxes for corporate and general assistance purposes of Lisle Township on November 10, 2010, (the "Levy Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Levy Ordinance authorized a direct annual tax for corporate purposes to be levied upon all of the taxable property within Lisle Township; and

WHEREAS, the tax levy so authorized by the Levy Ordinance to be collected in 2011, is Two Million Two Hundred Seventy Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$2,277,900.00); and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has reduced the 2011 – 2012 tentative budget, and has determined that the Levy Ordinance should be reduced by an equal amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Supervisor and Board of Town Trustees, of Lisle Township, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the County Clerk of DuPage County be and is hereby authorized and directed to abate the amount of Seventy One Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Six Dollars and No Cents (\$71,526.00) from the 2010 Lisle Township Tax Levy Ordinance to be collected in 2011.

Section 2. That the total amount of the 2010 Township tax levy for taxes to be collected in 2011 shall be Two Million Two Hundred Six Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Four Dollars and No Cents (\$2,206,374.00) following the abatement set forth in Section 1.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Lisle Township is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of DuPage County, Illinois.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
