

PROPOSITION TO ASK VOTERS IF THEY WOULD LIKE THE NINE TOWNSHIPS IN DUPAGE COUNTY TO PROVIDE THE MOSQUITO ABATEMENT SERVICES IN AN EFFORT TO CONSOLIDATE SERVICES AND PROVIDE GREATER HEALTH BENEFITS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Town Trustees (the "Board") of Lisle Township, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Township"), is not presently contracting for Mosquito Abatement Services for any part of the Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Board desires direction from the residents of the Township on the question of whether they would like the Township to contract for the Mosquito Abatement Services; and,

WHEREAS, there are currently over 40 units of government in DuPage County providing some form of mosquito abatement services to their residents, and

WHEREAS, there is much discussion county-wide on consolidation of services by local governments, and it has been suggested that having the nine townships of DuPage County assume the responsibilities of mosquito abatement services would possibly offer consistent coverage throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of the Township has recommended, and the Board does hereby find and determine, that a nonbinding referendum question on the November 8, 2016 General Election ballot may be the best way to gauge how the residents of the Township feel regarding this question; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Supervisor and the Board of Town Trustees of Lisle Township, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the proposition hereinabove referred to be submitted to the voters of the Township in accordance with the general election law at the General Election to be held on Tuesday, the 8th of November 2016, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on said day (the Election).

Section 2. That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and the polling places established by the Board of Election Commissioners of the County of DuPage (the "Election Authority"), for the voters of the Township at said general election.

Section 3. That the Election Authority of said County shall give notice of the election in accordance with the general election law by publishing notice thereof once in one or more local, community newspapers published and having general circulation in the Township, and also once in a newspaper published in said County, the dates of such publications of said notice to be not more than thirty (30) or less than ten (10) days prior to the date set for the Election.

Section 4. That it is hereby found and determined that the Daily Herald is a local community newspaper published and having general circulation in the Township and County as required by Sections 12-4 and 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code").

Section 5. That said notice shall include the following:

Section 7. That the election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the general election law.

Section 8. That all ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this ordinance be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

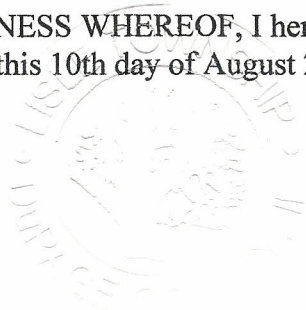


