#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-1**

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUPERVISOR TO PAY ROUTINE INVOICES AND EXPENDITURES NOT TO EXCEED A CERTAIN AMOUNT

WHEREAS, Lisle Township is an Illinois public entity operating under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Township is a unit of local government established and governed by the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township receives certain bills, such as utility bills, on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS, at times, the Township Board does not have a meeting regularly scheduled to occur between the time it receives the bills and the time the payment for those bills is due; and

WHEREAS, the Township does not want to incur late fees or charges by failing to pay invoices by their due dates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE SUPERVISOR AND TOWNSHIP BOARD OF LISLE TOWNSHIP, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Township Supervisor is hereby authorized to pay routine bills that are submitted by vendors to the Township or the Lisle Township Road District on a monthly basis related to utilities or other services or functions related to the Township's or Road District's operational needs not to exceed the amount of \$1000 per invoice when the Township has received an invoice which is due prior to the next regular Township Board meeting, and provided that, with respect to Road District invoices, said payment has been approved by the Highway Commissioner.

**SECTION 2**: The Township Supervisor is authorized to pay credit card bills for credit

cards issued to Lisle Township and the Lisle Township Road District for expenses advanced on

behalf of Lisle Township not to exceed the amount of \$500 per statement when the Township

has received an invoice which is due prior to the next regular Township Board meeting, and

further provided that, with Road District expenditures, the Highway Commissioner has approved

the expenditure.

**SECTION 3:** In the event that the Supervisor pays any invoices pursuant to Sections 1

or 2 above, such invoices and expenditures shall be reported to the Township Board for

ratification at the next regular Board meeting following the expenditure or the commitment of

the expenditure.

**SECTION 4:** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be

held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution.

**SECTION 5:** All Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of

such conflict.

SECTION 6: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from after its passage,

approval and publication as provided by law.
