## BRANCH PICK UP BEGINS MAY 4TH

**Bundled branches will be picked up SIX TIMES in 2020, beginning the FIRST MONDAY of MAY and continuing through October, starting on the first Monday of each month. If Monday is a holiday, then we start the next day.**

The start dates and the rules are listed to the right. You may want to save this list so you can time your trimming to our pick-up dates.

Have your **tied up bundles** at curbside or roadside by 6:30 a.m. on those Monday

mornings. Our crew is on a rotating street schedule and it may take them 3 to 5 days to complete the branch collection. They will visit each area and street only once.

Branches must be tied up in bundles. We will leave a "red tag" explanation if we don't pick up your branches.

### FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- ◇ **Branches cut to 4 feet**
- ◇ **Branch diameter 4 inches or less**
- ◇ **Bundles must be tied with twine or string (no wire or plastic)**
- ◇ **Bundles up to 25 lbs. only**

### START DATES

- MAY 4
- JUNE 1
- JULY 6
- AUGUST 3
- SEPTEMBER 8 (Tuesday)
- OCTOBER 5

Did you know Lisle Township encompasses approximately 36 square miles with almost 3,400 unincorporated households in DuPage County?

The Road District maintains most of the unincorporated public right-a-ways and extends from roughly Washington St. (Naperville) to Woodward Ave. (Downers Grove) and south to 87th St.

Our program is intended to help homeowners with the disposal of tree and shrub branches that do not qualify as yard waste. If it fits in a yard waste bag it should not be in the roadside bundle for us. Our collection service is not meant to remove whole trees. Please make

other arrangements for removal when a tree is cut down.

**Please don't put your branch bundles in the street.** Place them in the parkway closest to the curb or the edge of the road. Also, we may not be able to pick them up if a

parked car is in the way. This township service is offered only to residences along the roads that we maintain in unincorporated Lisle Township. Please call if you are unsure if we service your road.

# Sidewalk Squares Replacement Program



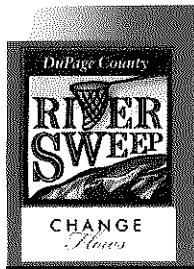
**REDUCED COST PROGRAM EXTENDED!**  
***Deadline Monday July 15th***

To help homeowners replace cracked, raised or sunken sidewalks, Lisle Township Road District will pick up the majority of the

cost when we replace. Call 630-964-0057 or email [highway@lisle-township.com](mailto:highway@lisle-township.com) by July 15th to be put on the sidewalk replacement list. Your cost will be \$1.25 per square foot which is \$31.25 for the typical 5' x 5' section.

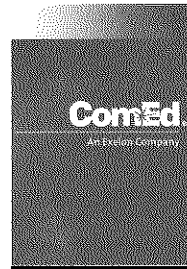
Our superintendent will leave an invoice-agreement form after he measures. Return the form with payment in full. The work usually begins in August.

Project start dates have not yet been determined. Flyers will be distributed to the homes along these streets about 5 days before construction begins. They will explain the repair process and outline any driving and parking restrictions.

We apply surface treatments to preserve and restore other township roads.

**Reclamite** is a sealant used on one year old roads and is reapplied every 4 years. About 13 of our roads are on this schedule.

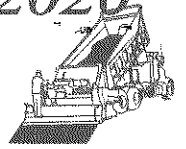

Did we have a winter? Some snow early- Halloween, and no major storms afterward. We had lots of predicted big snowfalls, but all missed the Township. The mild winter gave us a chance to do some tree removal/trimming work, but we still have a significant backlog. I want to remind you to call if you have any concerns about the tree removal process or notice a safety concern.

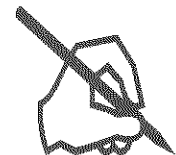
I am pleased to announce that the tax levy for 2020 has been reduced by 10%. We strive to deliver superior service yet continue to find ways to reduce costs. Despite the cut in the levy we will continue the reduced price sidewalk replacement program. Last year's sidewalk program was widely accepted as we replaced approximately 7 times more sidewalk squares than normal. As a result of the program, the Township looks better and is a safer

place for all of us to walk, especially the school children.

The Road District replaced our 2002 Elgin street sweeper and our 1987 sign utility truck. Our capital expenditures are financed through savings - we carry no debt.

Our staff has been stable, and I believe we have a great crew. I am pleased that we had only one minor accident this past year and it did not result in any lost time. The

Road District's work is hazardous, and I am gratified that the staff is safety conscious. Finally, I would like to thank our great crew for the fantastic job they did this past year.
