## *BRANCH PICK UP BEGINS MAY 2nd*

**Bundled branches will be picked up SIX TIMES in 2022, usually beginning the FIRST MONDAY of MAY and continuing through October.** The start dates and the rules are listed to the right.

You may want to save this list so you can time your trimming to our pick-up dates.

Have your tied up bundles at curbside or roadside by 6:30 a.m. on those Monday mornings. Our crew is on a rotating street schedule and it may take them 3 to 5 days to complete the branch collection. They

will visit each area and street only once.

Branches must be tied up in bundles. We will leave a "red tag" explanation if we don't pick up your branches.

### START DATES

- MAY 2 (MONDAY)
- JUNE 6 (MONDAY)
- JULY 6 (WEDNESDAY)
- AUGUST 1 (MONDAY)
- SEPTEMBER 6 (TUESDAY)
- OCTOBER 3 (MONDAY)

### FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- ◇ **Branches cut to 4 feet**
- ◇ **Branch diameter 4 inches or less**
- ◇ **Bundles must be tied with twine or string (no wire or plastic)**
- ◇ **Bundles up to 25 lbs. only**

### did you know?

... if you live in unincorporated DuPage County, a permit/bond is required for most construction projects from DuPage and Lisle Township Road District?

Call our office and we can help you through our quick and easy process. Some examples are driveway, roof, solar panels, patios, decks, demolitions and additions.

There are a few projects that require county permits but are exempt from township permits. The Road District can issue waivers for projects such as fences, sheds without concrete floors, underground sprinklers and alarm systems.

Our program is intended to help homeowners with the disposal of tree and shrub branches that do not qualify as yard waste. If it fits in a yard waste bag it should not be in the roadside bundle for us. Our collection service is not meant to remove

whole trees. Please make other arrangements for removal when a tree is cut down.

Please don't put your branch bundles in the street. Place them in the parkway closest to the curb or the edge of the road. Also, we may not be able

to pick them up if a parked car is in the way.

This township service is offered only to residences along the roads that we maintain in unincorporated Lisle Township. Please call if you are unsure if we service your road.

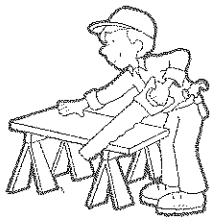
# SIDEWALK SQUARES REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

**Deadline Monday, July 11th**

To help homeowners replace cracked, raised or sunken sidewalks, Lisle Township Road District will pick up more than half the cost when we replace. Call 630-964-0057 or email: [highway@lisetownship.com](mailto:highway@lisetownship.com) by July 11th to be put on the sidewalk replacement list.

Your special cost will be \$1.25 per square

foot which is \$31.25 for the typical 5' x 5' section. Mark the squares you wish to replace with a dot of white paint. Our superintendent will leave an invoice-agreement form after he measures. Return the form with payment in full. The work usually begins in August.



## DUPAGE COUNTY

### BUILDING PERMITS

On January 31, 2022, the DuPage County Building Department went paperless and began **only** accepting permit applications **online**. Paper applications for the county are no longer accepted. Their staff is available to assist those who need help, Monday through Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm. Lisle Township Road District has not changed their permitting process. You will need an Entrance Permit, or sometimes a bond waiver, when a permit is required by the County. You will need to pay for the Township's permit first and provide a copy before paying for the county's permit. It is recommended you call our office (630-964-0057) prior to coming in so your permit will be ready. The Road District is accepting payment in person (check or cash) but you are always welcome to mail your payment and then we will email you the issued permit. Feel free to call our office with any questions. We are happy to help. Our office hours are Monday—Friday 7:00am—3:00pm.

*3pm — 6pm Friday, July 8th and 9am—Noon Saturday, July 9th*

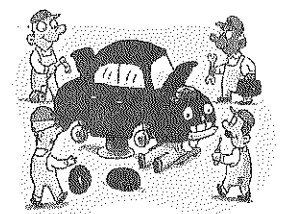

## ROAD MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE FOR 2022



The township roads being resurfaced this season are listed below. Approximately 2 inches of surface is removed and replaced with new asphalt.

Project start dates have not yet been determined.

FLYERS will be distributed to the homes along these streets about 5 days before construction begins. They will explain the repair process and outline any

driving and parking restrictions.

We apply surface treatments to preserve and restore other township roads.

**Reclamite** is a sealant used on one year old roads and is reapplied every 4 years. About 11 roads are on this schedule.

Our reclamite contractor will seal one side of the street at a time, so at least one lane is open for resident traffic. The sealants need up to four hours of drying time before the lane is opened.

**Crack-filling** seals cracks too big for the other products to repair. Contractors clean out the cracks then fill them.

RESIDENTS living on streets where this work will be done will be notified by flyer before the work starts.

OUR goal is to provide safe, durable and attractive roads and right-of-ways, while minimizing inconvenience to residents.

CALL... **JULIE BEFORE YOU DIG.COM**  
Protect Yourself And Your Family

J.U.L.I.E., INC. is a not-for-profit corporation dedicated to keeping Illinois safe and connected. JULIE stands for Joint Utility Locating Information for Excavators.

In Illinois, safe digging starts when you call JULIE at **8-1-1** (the nationwide 3 digit number to have your underground utility lines marked at no cost) or go online to enter a locate request at <https://www.illinois1call.com/remoteticketentry>.

State law requires you to notify JULIE at least two but not more than 14 business days before any digging project regardless of the project size or depth. Even if you are digging in the same area as previous projects, notify JULIE first!

Across the country, every few minutes an underground utility line is damaged because someone decided to dig without contacting a one-call center such as JULIE first. Again, this is a **free service**. JULIE neither owns nor marks any underground utility lines.

## Stormwater Management Program Plan (SMPP)

Lisle Township has a General Permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) for its Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) and as such the Township has developed this stormwater management program to prevent and reduce pollution to its storm sewer system to the maximum extent practicable. This document describes the pollution prevention practices that comprise the Township's stormwater management program.

### **Public Education and Outreach**

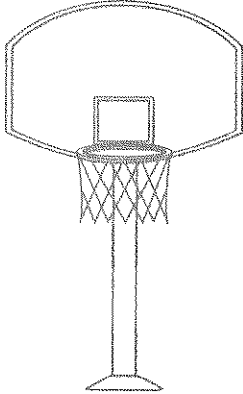

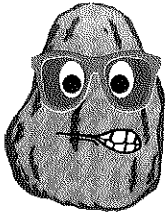
